#### **HOLY SPIRIT**

THE BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT MAKES US ROYAL.

THE INDWELLING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IS THE SIGN, BADGE OF ROYALTY.

YOU CANNOT LOSE THE INDWELLING HOLY SPIRIT. YOU CAN LOSE THE INDWELLING CHRIST (2 Corinthians 13:5; Revelation 3:15, 19, 20).

> Regaining of the Indwelling Christ

The carnal, non-perceptive believer is punished by the removal of the Indwelling Christ.

Ephesians 4:30 - Grieving the Holy Spirit, Carnality, Sin - weakness of the OSN

1 John 5:19 - Quenching the Holy Spirit - horizontal good manifesting the strengths of the OSN

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BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT is God the HS taking the believer at the moment of salvation and putting him into the Family of God (I Corinthians 12:13; Colossians 2:12).

INDWELLING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT is God the Holy Spirit coming to make His residence inside the believer at the moment a person accepts Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord (I Corinthians 6:19; Galatians 3:2). While the indwelling Spirit never leaves the Christian, He may or may not be in control of the life. Christians are never, in the Church Age, commanded to be baptized or indwelt by the Holy Spirit. There is one act of indwelling, and one act of baptism. These occur at the point of regeneration – new birth.

FILLING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT is the means by which a Christian is cleansed of sin (COS), Christ controlled, and prepared for the reception, absorption, assimilation, appropriation and application of the Word of God. The Christian life is a human impossibility. Therefore, when a person is controlled by the Holy Spirit he is controlled by a power greater than man's. That power is absolutely necessary to break the hold of the flesh, which the Bible calls carnality!

Look again Revelation 3:19 - "As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore and repent."

## **REPENT**

- I. NOUN metanoia ( $\mu \in \tau \acute{\alpha} \nu \circ \iota \alpha$ ) NOEO, from NOUS (mind), appended to META (change), thus the compound word means *CHANGE OF MIND*.
- II. VERB metanoeo (μετανοέω)
- III. VERB metamelomai (μεταμέλομαι)

## REPENTANCE - metanoeo

Metanoeo is a combination of two words:

- > The suffix Noeo ( $\nu$ 0 $\epsilon$  $\omega$ ) literally means "to direct one's mind to a subject". In classical Greek, it meant "to perceive" or "to notice".
- ➤ Meta is the prefix; the preposition in compounds means "after", "with", "around", etc.

The compound word literally means "after directing one's mind to a subject." But what did it mean to the Greeks?  $\mu \in \tau \alpha \nu o \in \omega = can first mean "to note after, later", or it can then mean "to change one's mind", "adopt another view" or "to change one's feelings"; if the change of mind derives from recognition that the earlier view was foolish, improper or evil, there arises a sense of "to regret", "to feel remorse", or "to rue".$ 

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Theologically, Repent is:

change of mind
a change of plans

➤ a change of feelings
➤ to reflect

a change of intentions
to reconsider a first opinion

### **REPENTANCE**

I. WORD USED IN OT-Nacham "Then repenteth God" God changes His mind, or changes His Policy! 7 OT passages: Genesis 6:6; Exodus 32:14; Judges 2:18; I Samuel 15:35; Psalm 90:13; Jeremiah 15:6; Amos 7:3,6.

- II. These expressions of Repentance are all anthropopathisms ascribing to God human characteristics.
  - 1. ANTHROPOPATHISM
  - 2. ANTHROPOMORPHISM
- III. Greek Words translated Repent:
  - 1. Noun *metanoia* μ∈τανοια Repent, Repentance
  - 2. Verb metanoew  $\mu\epsilon\tau\alpha\nuo\epsilon\omega$  To change;  $\mu\epsilon\tau\alpha$  = change,  $\nuo\epsilon\omega$  = mind or thinking; The word means a complete change of mental attitude about something a reversal of mind!
    - a. Study: Transitive and Intransitive verbs
      - > A transitive verb has a subject and an object. "He built a house"
      - > An intransitive verb does not require an object. "He ran" makes complete sense.
    - b. There are two categories of the use of the Greek word REPENT (The *lost person,* the subject, or the *saved person,* the subject).
      - ➤ If the Lost person is the *subject*, then the Lord Jesus Christ is the *object*. The unsaved person has a mind-change, and by Faith accepts God's provision. The results: Salvation.
      - $\triangleright$  When the saved person is the subject, then the object will be: Works of the Flesh, (dead works) carnality, indifference, non-perception, satanic thinking (<u>Revelation 2:5; 2:16; 2:22; 3:19</u> μετανοέω)
  - 3. Verb *metamelomai* μεταμέλομαι Regret, with *emotional* connotation.

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There are four uses of  $\mu \in \tau \alpha \mu \in \lambda \circ \mu \alpha \iota$ :

- ➤ <u>Matthew 21:28,29</u> Regret
- ➤ Matthew 27:3 Emotion
- > Romans 11:29 No Regrets
- ➤ <u>Hebrews 7:21</u> No Regrets
- IV. Getting out of non-perception requires a *change of thinking*. Satanic thinking is removed with *divine thinking* (Revelation 2:5; 2:16; 2:22; 3:19 the word used in all of these verses is:  $\mu \epsilon \tau \alpha \nu o \epsilon \omega$ , meaning *change of mind*).
