Read Revelation 20:1-11. Key verse for this session is Verse 9.

REVELATION 20:9 NOTES – "What Does Satan Have in Mind?"

The end of the REVOLT is presented here. Satan will be well organized, well armed.

"Breadth of the earth (or land)" means the entire earth.

What Satan has in mind is to attack Jerusalem – the place where Jesus will return at the 2nd Advent (Zech. 14:1-9). Jerusalem is also the capital, where Christ reigns. Jerusalem is also the home of the Jews; Satan's first attempt is to wipe them out, so that God cannot fulfill the 4 unconditional covenants to the Jews.

Davidic Covenant

> Palestinian Covenant

➤ New Covenant to Israel

Please note the <u>timeline</u> which emphasizes the 4 major events of Biblical history and study it briefly.

Look again at the literal translation, and the Greek, of Revelation 20:9.

Review the topic of **Covenants Defined**.

Now we review the **Abrahamic Covenant**.

Now look again at Revelation 20:9.

"And compassed (encircled) the camp of the saints, even the beloved city Jerusalem." END OF REVOLT

"And fire came down out of heaven and devoured them"

"From" (preposition Apo) means ultimate source of God. Gen. 12:1-3 tells us that those who practice anti-Semitism will be disciplined. God keeps His Word to Israel – they are protected! God keeps His Word to us today.
