## Wednesday, April 29, 2015 Bible Study Notes – "Unredeemed":

Note the enlarged Timeline Diagram, emphasizing the Tribulation period.

## Exegesis – Revelation 21:8

Note the last two words of this verse: [HO] THANATOS [HO] DEUTEROS, literally translated the death, the second. Now study briefly the <u>Categories of Death</u>.

Look again at the Greek of verse 8.

APISTOS is the word faith preceded by the alpha privative, meaning NO faith.

The present passive participle of *BOELLUSOMAI* is translated *having become foul*. The present tense means continuous action, passive voice means the unredeemed continue to *become foul*.

These *unredeemed ones* are described with the nouns *PHONEUSIN* (murderers), *PORNOIS* (fornicators), *FARKAMOIS* (sorcerers), *EIDOLOLATRAIS* (idolaters), and *PSEUDESIN* (false ones) in this verse.
