# Sunday Session 1 Bible Study – July 20, 2014 "Overwhelming Victory" – (Revelation 3:5)

#### Read Revelation 3:1-6

Note Revelation 3:5 – "The one overcoming, the same shall be clothed in garments white and by no means will I blot out his name out of the scroll of life, and I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels."

As human beings after Adam's fall, we are born *body and soul*. When we became believers, we were *born again*, becoming body, soul, *and spirit*. Our bodies are a truly amazing feat of engineering that only God could accomplish, and they are very important part of God's plan for us, but they are not the *real us*. It is the *soul* (and, when saved, the *spirit*) that is the real *us*.

#### SOUL'S NEED - DAILY BIBLE STUDY

- 1. The soul is always in a state of negative atmospheric pressure.
- 2. The inner part of the soul has a process that is constantly taking information received and storing it for future use.
- 3. There is always the interaction with the Old Sin Nature (OSN).
- 4. If one chooses to utilize spiritual fuel, but none exists, he will go into a panic mode and search frantically for answers.
- 5. Over time the consistent intake of the Word of God into the soul will remove evil and scars in the soul (God's Word does not transform us immediately, but over *time* we are transformed; that's why consistency is so important).
- 6. Whatever is in the soul will be expelled into the world. When we were saved, we received something called *imputed righteousness*. An unsaved person is body and soul only. The soul comprehends and categorizes things in the realm of the *physical* only. The Bible thus says that the things of the Spirit are foolishness to this person. The saved person is body, soul *and spirit;* and the human spirit is able to comprehend and categorize things in the realm of the *spiritual*.

## IMPUTATIONS are basis of Essential Doctrines of the Bible

- I. The imputation of Adam's sin to the human race this fact is the basis of the Doctrine of Original Sin.
- II. The imputation of sins of man to Christ, on which the Doctrine of Salvation is based.
- III. The Imputation of the Righteousness of God to those who believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, on which the Doctrine of Justification is based.

### **IMPUTATIONS:**

- I. Definition
  - A. It means to credit something to someone.
  - B. It involves both that which is imputed and the object of the imputation.
  - C. God is always the Source in scripture.
  - D. There are eight imputations in the Bible.

- E. All eight are irrevocable
- II. There are two general categories in imputation in the Bible:
  - A. Judicial: the object does not deserve or merit the imputation.
  - B. Real: that which is imputed and the object have an affinity or they deserve each other.
- III. There are two judicial imputations:
  - A. Christ bearing our sins in His body (II Corinthians 5:21).
  - B. Imputation of divine righteousness (+R) at the time of salvation (Romans 2:38; Galatians 3:6, 7).
- IV. Six "real" (deserved) imputations, in the order that they occur:
  - A. Human life to the soul at the point of physical birth (Isaiah 57:16).
  - B. Adam's original sin to the genetically formed OSN/STA (old sin nature/sinful trend of Adam Romans 3:23).
  - C. Eternal life to the soul in regeneration (John 3:16, 36 due to the presence of imputed Righteousness, or +R).
  - D. Temporal blessing to the mature believer (imputed +R Psalm 23:5) as a result of the maturity adjustment to the justice of God (MAJG).
  - E. Blessing and reward to the resurrection body at the judgment seat of Christ (I Corinthians 3:10-15).
  - F. Sin of unbelief to the resurrection body of the unbeliever at the Great White Throne Judgment.
- V. All eight imputations are irrevocable, because they are based on divine integrity.
- VI. The imputation of +R is based on faith, not works (Romans 3:22; Galatians 3).
