Sunday Session 2 Bible Study – July 20, 2014 "Clothed In White" – (Revelation 3:5, 6)


Read Revelation 3:1-6

Note Revelation 3:5 – "The one overcoming, the same shall be clothed in **garments white** and by no means will I blot out his name out of the scroll of life, and I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels."

Born physically alive in a dying body, and spiritually dead, we are all born with two problems. Jesus Christ came to solve both problems for us – and He did so when he said *"It is finished"*, then breathed out, and didn't breath back in, dying intentionally on our behalf, physically and spiritually. His physical death provides us in the future a resurrection body, and His spiritual death provides for us our eternal salvation and our eternal spirit.

REAL IMPUTATIONS:

LIFE TO THE SOUL

THE OSN GOES GENETICALLY INTO LIFE FROM THE FATHER ADAM'S OSN *COULD NOT GO INTO JESUS CHRIST* (NO EARTHLY FATHER), SO NO PRE-FABED HOME FOR IT.

Soul

- 1. Born with OSN (Ephesians 2:1; Romans 5:12).
- 2. Adam not created with OSN God is not the author of sin.
- 3. Adam and Eve created from that point all others perpetuated.
- 4. When Adam sinned his spirit died and he received an OSN.
- 5. The body is the "house" for the soul The *real you* is not the body, but the soul and spirit are the real you.
- Distinction must be made between the body and the spirit I Thessalonians 5:23; Hebrews 4:12.
- 7. The lost individual is described in I Corinthians 2:14 *PSUCHIKOS*.
- 8. When the lost person dies his soul continues to exist no destruction or annihilation, and no purification.
- 9. At birth there is a prefabricated place for life, which is the soul.
- 10. At birth, because of depravity (fall of man Adam's sin) there is a place (prefabricated) for the imputation of Adam's Original Sin – the place is the OSN. This spells condemnation. Had there been no condemnation at birth there could be no potential of Salvation at God-consciousness. Jesus Christ took our condemnation at the Cross, and was judged for us (A judicial judgment).
- 11. GOD IMPUTED TO US ADAM'S SIN, SO THAT HE COULD IMPUTE TO JESUS CHRIST OUR PERSONAL SINS.
