

Wednesday Bible Study – July 23, 2014

"Book Of Life" – (Revelation 3:5, 6)

Read Revelation 3:1-6

Now look at verse 5: *"The one overcoming, the same shall be clothed in garments white and by no means will I blot out his name out of the scroll of life, and I will confess his name before my Father and before his angels."*

Overcoming is the PAP n.m.s. of the word NIKAO.

PERIBALLO – Future Middle Indicative meaning *clothed*... literally, PERI = *Around* + BALLO = *To throw*.

This verb is in the middle voice, meaning the participants of *being clothed* will be benefitted by it.

OU ME are two negative adverbs put together, meaning *NO, NEVER, NEVER, NO, NEVER!*

BIBLOU – The word for *scroll*, sounds like the word Bible.

KAI HOMOLOGEO – *And I will confess*. This verb is in the indicative mood, or the mood of *reality*.

BOOK OF LIFE

The book of life is a registry of all people until they die.

If a person dies without accepting Jesus Christ as Savior, his name will be blotted out of the book of life.

TIME / ETERNITY

In time, the BOOK OF LIFE has all names, every person until death.

In Eternity future, the BOOK OF LIFE will have only the names of believers in the LJC.

Philippians 4:3; Revelation 3:5; 13:8; 17:8; 20:12; 20:15; 21:27; 22:19.

CHRIST DIED FOR EVERYONE

The Book of Life has all members of the human race in it.

When a lost person dies, his or her name is blotted out!

Note the diagram of the [Love System](#).

NO ONE EVER SINS APART FROM HIS OWN HUMAN CONSENT!

ONLY WHEN VOLITION PASSES TEMPTATION INTO THE SOUL DOES THE OSN CONTROL THE SOUL, AND THE INDIVIDUAL ENTERS THE COSMIC SYSTEM.

THE BELIEVER IS ONLY HONORABLE AND FREE FROM SIN INSIDE THE DIVINE POWER SPHERE.

Temptation is not sin, but yielding to it moves the one sinning out of fellowship with the Holy Spirit and with our Savior Jesus Christ.

Look now at Revelation 3:6. *"He that hath an ear; let him hear what the Spirit says unto the churches."*

EAR is the word AKOUSATO – We all have an ear! He gives us all a chance to hear and respond to His message.

AKOUO is a command in the imperative mood, but we can choose to obey or disobey.

He is saying that we *really need* to keep on hearing and responding to what He and to what the Spirit of God is saying to the churches.
