## Session 2 Bible Study Audio

Note again the Bulletin insert "Indwelling of the Holy Spirit" (review Points A-11, a-c) – We are commanded *not* to grieve or quench the Holy Spirit; we are commanded to be *filled* with, but *never* to be *indwelt* by, the Holy Spirit.

Information to Note – Reference: Topical Studies Doctrine of the Escutcheon, A Promise of Rewards – Points I-VI:

Note Topical Study: Deity Spoke at the Incarnation

When Christ came at the incarnation, His deity spoke, as we see In Hebrews 10:5 – "A body Thou hast prepared for me…" – this is actually a reference to Psalm 40:6 – "You have pierced my ears". That passage refers to the fact that in the ancient world when a person freely chose to be the slave of another, that person allowed a hole to be placed in his ear, earmarked for life. When Christ came into the world, His body was the *earmark*, or identification, or *escutcheon*, for the hypostatic union. Christ was saying, I have come willingly to become My Father's slave. Note also the use of this concept in Revelation 3:12.
