Review of Overhead Presentations:

- Greek/Literal Translation of [Romans 8:28](#). Points of Exegesis:
 1. οἴδαμεν – Present active indicative 1st person plural of OIDA – *We know that to*
 2. ἀγαπῶσιν – Present active participle, dative masculine plural of AGAPAO – *the ones loving*
 3. τὸν θεόν – TON THEOS – *The God*
 4. *The God works all things together for good (AGAPE) to the ones according to purpose (His) being called.*
- Dr. Schaeffer's 3 major imputations:
 1. The imputation of Adam's sin to the race, on which fact the Biblical concept of original sin is based;
 2. The imputation of the sin of man to Christ, on which fact the Biblical concept of salvation is based;
and
 3. The imputation of the righteousness of God to those who believe on Christ, on which fact the Biblical concept of justification is based.

[Three Major Imputations](#) / We know there are [8 total imputations](#) (2 judicial or *undeserved*, 6 real or *deserved*)

- [Romans 8:28 – X+Y+Z = God's Glory](#)
- [Confident Anticipation](#) Note again the 3 major imputations above.
- [God Gives Life](#) (Note again the XYZ radical of Rom. 8:28 above).
