WALKING – A BIBLICAL CONCEPT

"WALK WITH ME" (Rev. 3:4)

"WALK IN THE SPIRIT" (Gal. 5:16)

"WALK IN LOVE" (Eph. 5:2)

"WALK NOT AFTER THE FLESH" (Rom. 8:1)

- 1. The EZ (Echo Zone) believer walks consistently with the Lord.
- 2. Not a moribund Christian (one on the verge of becoming obsolete no vigor, stagnant, not advancing, about to die the *sin* unto death).
- 3. In Rev. 3:4, we have a remnant of non-defiled, truly committed believers, walking with the Lord. These fold are locked in and traveling God's High Way of Grace.
- 4. Walking is the word used in the New Testament to reveal a Christian filled with the Holy Spirit. Romans 8:2-4; Eph. 5:2; 5:18; and Gal. 5:16
- 5. Walking describes living one day at a time. Romans 14:5, 6; Eph. 5:6-18; James 4:13-15
- 6. In walking, balance is necessary. Living in the devils world also demands balance. Balance of soul is determined by a consistent diet of Spiritual food. Phil. 3:7; Col. 2:6
- 7. Walking describes God's system of learning. Eph. 5:15, we are to be on guard to walk circumspectly.
- 8. Areas of walking as believers in the Lord Jesus Christ include:
 - 1) Walk in the Holy Spirit. Gal. 5:16
 - 2) Walk in faith. 2 Cor. 5:7
 - 3) Walk in the truth of His Word. 3 John 3
- 9. The Bible declares that some walk as enemies of the Cross of Christ (Phil. 3:18). We are not to be rebellious and non-perceptive to the living Christ and the living Word.
- 10. The Bible uses the word "walk" to reveal a maturing Christian. One who:
 - 1) Walks "in the light" 1 John 1:7
 - 2) Walks "in newness of life" Rom. 6:4
 - 3) Walks "worthy of his vocation" Eph. 4:1
 - 4) Walks "in good works" Eph. 2:10; Col. 1:10
