

Definition of Dispensation:

1. A period of human history expressed in terms of Divine Revelation.
2. Dispensations are the Divine categories of human history or the Divine outline of human history.
3. In effect, dispensations are God's interpretation of history as well as a Divine plan for man related to time.
4. A believer must be oriented to time to understand God's plan. When we understand God's plan we understand God's purpose.
5. In every age or dispensation the plan of God operates through a specific agency. It was Israel and now it is the Church. In the millennium Christ will be the ruler.
6. Salvation is always the same in every dispensation, personal faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as He is revealed in that dispensation.
