## **EZ SCRIPTURES**

- 1. Romans 6:4 "Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk (AASubj 1<sup>st</sup> p.pl of περιπάτεω) in newness of life."
- 2. Ephesians 4:1 "I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that you walk (AAInf.) worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called."
- 3. Colossians 1:10 "That you might walk (AAInf) worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God."
- 4. Romans 13:13 "Let us walk (περιπατήωμεν) (AASubj. 1st p.pl. pf περιπάτεω) honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness (rioting is komois—excessive feastings, parting drunkenness is the Greek word methals=drunken bouts) not in chambering (Greek word koitais bed, me koitais = sex) and excesses (wantonness ἀσελγείαις) not in strife and envying."
- 5. Ephesians 2:10 "For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk (AASubj. 1<sup>st</sup> pl. περιπάτεω) in them."
- 6. <u>II Corinthians 5:7</u> "For we walk (PAI 1<sup>st</sup> p.pl.) by faith, not by sight."
- 7. Ephesians 5:2 "And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling savor."
- 8. Galatians 5:16 "Walk (PAImp) in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh."
- 9. Colossians 4:5 "Walk (PAImp 2<sup>nd</sup> p.pl of περιπάτεω) in wisdom toward them that are without, redeeming the time."
- 10. Walking describes the pattern and routine of Life for the Believer (Romans 14:5, 6; James 4:13-15).
