## Doctrinal Studies FEAR

- I. FEAR DEFINED: Two types
  - 1) As Beneficial, and to be encouraged Legitimate Fear: Awe, Respect, Reverence
  - 2) As a Detriment, and to be overcome Illegitimate Fear: anxiety, distress, alarm, trepidation, dread, fright.
  - Ten Hebrew words for Fear 8 verbs. In the NT there is a noun  $\phi \circ \beta \circ \sigma$  (PHOBOS) and the verb  $\phi \circ \beta \acute{\epsilon} \omega$  (PHOBEO)
- II. LEGITIMATE FEAR is used for occupation with Christ, construction of the spiritual house of the soul (2 Sam. 23:3; Neh. 5:9; Job 28:28; Ps. 19:9; Ps. 34:11; Prov. 1:7; Prov. 10:27; Prov. 15:16)
- III. COURAGE OR LACK OF FEAR is a sign of Maturity (Ps. 3:6; Ps. 56:3,11; Heb. 11:27 "By faith [Moses] forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king.", Heb. 13:5,6).
- IV. LOVE IS THE ABSENCE OF FEAR (I John 4:18 Literal translation: "Fear is not in love, but perfect love casts out the fear, because fear has punishment, and the one fearing has not been perfected in love.").

## Doctrinal Studies (Continued) FEAR

- > If we are characterized by fear, we will be cut off from the triumphant and victorious life.
- ➤ If we are properly related to God, there is the continuation of the casting out of fear.
- Fear brings about punishment, and the one fearing (perfect passive participle means the fearful one has become the *passive recipient* of fear) has not been perfected in love.
- $\triangleright$  The verb *perfected* in I John 4:18 is the perfect active infinitive of τελειοω (TELEIOO).

## **GREAT SCRIPTURES ON FEAR**

Ps. 34:11 "Come, you children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the Lord."

Ps. 19: 9 "The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever; the judgments of the Lord are true; they are righteous altogether."

Gen. 42:18 "Now Joseph said to them on the third day, "Do this and live, for I fear God:"

Ps. 23:4b "... I fear no evil for thou art with me..."

I John 4:18 "Fear is not in love, but perfect love casts out the fear, because fear has punishment, and the one fearing has not been perfected in love."

2 Cor. 11:3 "But I fear, that as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, your minds will be corrupted from the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ."

Gen. 15:1 "... Do not fear, Abram, I am a shield to you; your reward shall be very great."

The Lord does not want us to be frustrated and confused, fearful... Fear Isn't Necessary.
