Doctrinal Studies THE IMMUTABILITY OF GOD

As an infinite Being, absolutely independent and eternal, God is above the possibility of change.

Creatures change, everything earthly changes, but God does not change. He is and must be eternally the same, for He is infinitely perfect, and infinite perfection prevents and precludes change. Change implies imperfection.

There can be no addition to the number of His natural attributes, and there can be no increase of their capacity and power. It is absurd to suppose that God can be more Sovereign, more Eternal, more Powerful, more Knowing, more Loving or more Truth.

- I. Definition of Immutability: God in His nature, attributes and counsels, (advice, instruction, wisdom, discretion, consultation) is unchanging. This does not imply that God is incapable of making free choices for to God belongs the right to choose ends and means of attaining them. Immutability does not imply inactivity or immobility for God is Infinite in power and energy.
- II. Biblical fact of Immutability: Mal 3:6 "For I am the Lord, I change not..." James 1:17 "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness (no shifting; God's Grace is stable) and not casting of a shadow (eclipse)." God's Grace is NEVER eclipsed.
- III. God is absolute stability: Isaiah 40:28 "Hast thou not known? Hast thou not heard, that the everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary?"
- IV. His Word and His Works are unchanging: Psa 119:89 "Forever, O Lord, thy Word is settled in heaven." Eccl 3:14 "I know that, whatsoever God doeth, it shall be forever, nothing can be put to it, nor anything taken from it...." Isa 40:8 "The grass withereth the flower fadeth: but the Word of our God shall stand for ever."
- V. From His immutability stems His faithfulness Psa 36:5 "Thy mercy, O Lord, is in the heavens: and thy faithfulness reacheth unto the clouds." Psa 89:33 "My loving kindness will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail." Psa 119:90 "Thy faithfulness is unto all generations: thou hast established the earth, and it abideth." Lam 3:22, 23 "It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness."
