- a. Matt. 4:1 "Then was led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil
- b. Just as the servant of Jehovah, Jesus, took His own initiative in nothing but always acted under orders being directed in His movement by the Holy Spirit, to whom He was subject.

Luke 4:1 "And Jesus being full of the Holy Spirit returning from Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness" also see John 3:34

V. Accomplished His ministry in the power of the Holy Spirit

Luke 4:18, 19 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor, he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised. To preach the acceptable year of the Lord" Also Isa 61:1 and Luke 4:14

VI. He sacrificially offered Himself through the Spirit

Heb 9:14 "How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God"

VII. Resurrected by the power of the Holy Spirit

Romans 8:11 "But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead also quickened your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you" Also see Romans 1:4

VIII. Commandment to the apostles after His resurrection given through the Holy Spirit.

Acts 1:1,2 "The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach, until the day in which He was taken up, after that he through the Holy Spirit had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen."

IX. Bestower of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

Acts 2:33 "Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear"

X. The filling of the Holy Spirit and utilization of truth brings victory.

Jesus Christ lived His life in absolute dependence on – and subjection to – the Holy Spirit.
