German Translation: Jonah 1:7-11

Verse 7 – And they said one to another, Come, and let us loose throw, that we may know for whose cause this misfortune we [met]! And they threw en loose, and the lot fell on Jonah. *** (throwing loose here means to throw the dice loose, as in loosing them from your hand)

Verse 8 – And they said to him: Tell us now, by whose [guilt] this disaster we [meet]! What is your profession, and where are you from? What is your land, and of what people are you?

Verse 9 – And he said to them, I am a Hebrew, and I fear the LORD, the God of heaven who made the sea and the dry [land].

Verse 10 – And the men exceedingly afraid, and said to him: What have you done? The men had namely learned that he was fleeing from the presence of the LORD, because he had told them.

Verse 11 – And they said to him: What shall we do [with] you, that the sea may leave us alone? For the sea was getting stormy.
