LAST JUDGMENT

- I. People who do not face God's justice in time will receive Divine Justice in Eternity-2nd Death-Great White Throne Judgment – John 5:22
 - 1. The Last Judgment is the alternative to salvation
 - 2. God is perfect in Righteousness and Justice
 - 3. He found a way in time to keep from compromising these two characteristics
 - 4. Christ did this in Propitiation
- II. The human race is divided into two categories:
 - 1. BELIEVER – Perceptive, who has accepted the Lord Jesus Christ. The Good news of the Gospel – John 3:18 “He that believeth is not condemned”
 - 2. UNBELIEVER – Negative, Non-perceptive, one who has rejected Jesus Christ – Eternal condemnation – John 3:36 “He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.”
- III. In the last Judgment the Unbeliever is under indictment based on rejection of Jesus Christ as Savior. John 16:9 “of sin because they believe not on me”. Rev. 20:15 “Whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the Lake of Fire.
- IV. No believer is involved in the Last Judgment-Rom. 8:1.
- V. The Unbeliever has two appointments with God:
 - 1. Death
 - 2. Last Judgment - Heb.9:27, 28
- VI. The second appointment is kept by a 2nd Resurrection. John 5:24-29; Dan. 12:2 God takes all unbelievers and resurrects them at the end of time – after the Gog revolution for the Great White Throne Judgment.
- VII. The Resurrected unbeliever is condemned on the basis of his human good (works of the flesh) – not sin. Rev. 20:12,13
- VIII. The Eternal State of the lost is the Lake of Fire forever – Matt.25:41 “Then he shall say unto them on the left hand, depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels.” Rev. 20:14,15.
