I. THE GIFT

- 1. The gift of apostle and prophet are temporary gifts.
- 2. The gift of evangelist and PT carry the Church to the Rapture.
- 3. The gift of PT is a "hyphenated gift" because one definite article serves both "pastors" and "teachers", while the conjunction "and" acts as a hyphen. (Two words are employed, but only one idea is intended. This is called a "hendiadus")
- 4. The word "Pastor" means shepherd and metaphorically refers to the one who is in charge of a flock of sheep.
- 5. The second noun "teachers", emphasizes the individual Pastor's number one priority as a leader; namely to lead the sheep to spiritual nourishment (Jn.21:15-17).
- 6. The thrust of this gift is to equip the Royal family to carry out the various aspects of the ministry, to bring perceptive volition to maturity (Eph.4:12,13).

II. SYNONYMS

- 1. Messenger-aggelos, a spokesman for God to the local church (Rev.2:1,8,12,18;3:1,7,14)
- 2. Minister-diadonos, doulos, a servant to perceptive volition (Mk.10:43,44; I Cor.3:5)
- 3. Teacher-didaskalos, the Pastor's responsibility to communicate the contents of Scripture (I Tim.2:7; 2 Tim.1:11)
- 4. Bondslave-the Pastor is to obey God and trust Him in all aspects of his ministry (Lk.12:43; Rom.1:1; 2 Tim.2:24; Ti.1:1)
- 5. Overseer-episkopos, the Pastor is to watch over the general welfare of the flock (Acts 20:28;I Tim.3:2)
- 6. Herald-kerux, clearly and emphatically declare God's Word, no matter the response (2 Pet.2:5; I Tim.2:7 (vb.occurs 61X
- 7. Shepherd-poimaino, a Pastoral metaphor (Jn.10:2; Eph.4:11)
- 8. Elder-presbuteros, a word of Jewish origin indicating respect believers are to show spiritual leaders (I Pet.5:1,5; 2 Jn.1; 3 Jn.)
