REVELATION 21:1-5 NOTES - "New Heaven and a New Earth"

Review the <u>Timeline with the 4 major events</u> in history. After the Tribulation, John is shown <u>Revelation 21:1-5</u> – *THE ETERNAL STATE – ETERNITY CANNOT REALLY BE DESCRIBED IN HUMAN TERMINOLOGY* (but let's try).

<u>Revelation 21:1</u> – "And I saw a new heaven and a new earth." A new replacement is presented here – the universe in which we now live will be totally destroyed (2 Peter 3:3-13 – read).

The Bible actually presents three Heavens and three earths:

- 1. The original creation Genesis 1:1, 2; 2 Peter 3:5.
- 2. The restored earth Genesis 1:3-31; 2 Peter 3:7 The original earth was created instantly; the restored earth was created in 6 days.
- 3. We have the new heaven and the new earth in Rev. 21:1, and in 2 Peter 3:13 (The new heaven has been described as the eternal residence of the Church). The New Earth is the eternal residence of the Old Testament saints the regenerate of Israel.

"Passed away" (a orist active indicative, 3^{rd} person plural of $\dot{\alpha}\pi\dot{\epsilon}\rho\chi o\mu\alpha\iota$)

"And there was no more sea." – In this new heaven and the new earth, GOD GAVE AND GIVES LIGHT (Read Gen. 1:1-10. A Missouri Botanical Garden article (Copyright 2002), describes ocean light (three "Light Zones" – See full article). In this New Heaven and Earth Jesus Christ is, and will be the Light, along with the light from resurrection bodies of believers. Also, the angels in their bodily construction have a certain amount of light.

Revelation 21:2 – "And I (John) saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband." Note: Rev. 21:9-22:5 describes the Jerusalem of Eternity! It is a city 1500 miles high, 1500 miles wide, and 1500 miles long, suspended above the earth.

"From God" – apo – from the ultimate source – God is the ultimate source of the new Universe. The Holy City of the New Jerusalem fulfills 3 functions:

- 1. It is the headquarters for the universe of Eternity. It will be the personal residence of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2. It fulfills the promise to Abraham God said to Abraham "I will provide for you by my Grace a city." And Abraham said: "I believe that promise… therefore I will live in a tent until that promise is fulfilled." (Heb. 11:9, 10, 13 he died in a tent, but as we see in Rev. 21:9-22:5, this city was worth waiting for for Abe).
- 3. The third function of the New Jerusalem is that it reveals the glory of eternity! Eternity is all glory and glamour.

REVELATION 21:1-5 NOTES – New Heaven and a New Earth (Continued)

<u>Revelation 21:3-5</u> – Here, we have the first of the 3 characteristics of the eternal state:

1. Verse 3 – Jesus Christ will be there (*PERSONAL PRESENCE*) – "Tabernacle of God", an entire system of Christology; it is a presentation of the Lord Jesus Christ Himself. This is Jesus Christ in Resurrection body – In the tabernacle, Jesus Christ dwelt in Shekinah Glory ("And he shall dwell with them" means the regenerate of Israel – this is the fulfillment of the unconditional covenants to Israel). "And they (the regenerate of Israel) shall be His people and God himself shall be with them and be their God".

(We will continue in verses 4 and 5 next week.)

- 2. Verse 4 presents the 2nd characteristic of Eternity *PERFECT HAPPINESS*. Tears of pressure are removed, with no more death, or sorrow (mental agony) or pain (physical agony).
- 3. Verse 5 gives the 3rd characteristic of the eternal state: *PERPETUAL NEWNESS* (nothing will wear out or get old). In verse 5, John is told that these "words are TRUE and FAITHFUL."

He is pistos (πιστοῖ) – faithful; He is alethinoi (ἀληθινοι) – true.

HE WILL NOT GO BACK ON HIS WORD - HE KEEPS HIS PROMISES!

Here, we have our Lord's immutability and veracity.
