

Revelation 1:9

1. John the Apostle was the son of Zebedee-brother of James
2. "Disciple" whom Jesus loved
3. First a disciple of the John the Baptist – later one of the 12
4. Peter, James and John were the only witness of the Transfiguration (Matt. 17:1) and the agony of Gethsemane (Matt. 26:37)
5. John and Peter were sent into the city to make preparation for the final Passover meal – the last Supper (Luke 22:8)
6. At the meal his place was next to Jesus on whose chest he leaned (John 13:23,25)
7. John and Peter followed Jesus after the arrest into the palace of the High-Priest (John 18:5)
8. John, alone, remained near Jesus at the foot of the Cross on Calvary with Jesus' Mother, Mary. (John 19:25-27)
9. After the Resurrection John (with Peter) was the first of the disciples to run towards the grave.
10. John 20:2-10 – First to believe that Christ had truly RISEN.
