Sunday, April 26, 2015 - Session 1 - "A Gift Without Payment" - Bible Study Notes:

Read Revelation 21:1-8, starting with a description of the eternal state, followed by a transitional statement from our Lord, beginning in verse 6. Note a quick look at the Greek of verse 6.

Review the Timeline emphasizing the 4 major events in the Biblical time-line. Now, review the magnification of that timeline, emphasizing the Church, the Rapture and two phases of the Tribulation, the Battle of Armageddon, Satan bound in the Millennium ending with his brief release and certain defeat at the Gog and Magog revolution, the Great White Throne judgment and the establishment of the New Jerusalem to begin the Eternal state.

HOLY CITY – JERUSALEM

- I. JESUS CHRIST WILL BE THERE PERSONAL PRESENCE
- II. PERFECT HAPPINESS TEARS, DEATH, SORROW AND PAIN GONE FOREVER
- III. PERPETUAL NEWNESS NOTHING WILL GROW OLD

Read I Thessalonians 4:13-17 and I Corinthians 15:51-58, and note again the timeline.

Exegesis of Revelation 21:6

GINOMAI – Perfect tense means it was done and consummated in the past, with the results continuing.

ALPHA – Beginning; KAI – and; OMEGA – End. Our Lord is saying "I am the Beginning, The End, and Everything in between".

"I will give..." – This is a gift without payment. Note the German translation of verse 6.

DORIAN – A gift given freely, a Gift Without Payment. Read John 4:3-10; verse 10 uses this word $\delta\omega\varrho\varepsilon\dot{\alpha}\nu$.

Now, Study the topic, <u>Gift Without Payment</u>.
