## **Cosmic System**

- 1. What is the Cosmic Believer?
  - a. Just as the Divine Dynasphere (DD) is the Divine factory for the manufacture of winners, so the Cosmic System (CS) is Satan's factory for the manufacture of losers.
  - b. The Believer living in the CS is classified under six biblical categories:
    - i. An enemy of the Cross. Phil 3:18
    - ii. An enemy of God. James 4:4
    - iii. A hater of God. John 15:23
    - iv. Anti-Christ. 1 John 2:18,22; 4:3; 2 John 7
    - v. A carnal believer. Rom 8:7; 1Cor 3:3
    - vi. Double-minded. James 4:8
  - c. The CS is divided into two sub-systems: Cosmic One and Cosmic Two (see part 2 for the differences)
  - d. The relationship of the cosmic believer to the Holy Spirit falls into two categories:
    - i. In Cosmic One, he grieves the Holy Spirit. Eph 4:30
    - ii. In Cosmic Two, he quenches the Holy Spirit. 2Thess. 5:19
  - e. The status quo of the cosmic believer regarding his soul.
    - i. In Cosmic one, He has black-out of the soul.
    - ii. In Cosmic two, he has scar tissue of the soul.
  - f. All Christian service performed in the CS is classified as wood, hay, and stubble; it will be burned at the Judgment Seat of Christ. 1 Cor 3:11-16
- 2. Differences between Cosmic One and Cosmic Two:

COSMIC ONE	COSMIC TWO
1. Emphasizes arrogance; preoccupation with self.	1. Emphasizes animosity, hatred antagonism, rejection of God's Plan for the believer
2. Target: ego, self-consciousness of soul	Target: Truth or Doctrine
3. Result of hit: Preoccupation & obsession with self to the exclusion of God and Man.	3. Result of hit: Antagonism toward Christ as the living Word and Doctrine as the written Word.
4. Emphasized in contrast to God and objective reality.	4. Stresses human viewpoint over Divine viewpoint.
5. Represents Satan's attitude at the time of his pre-historic fall.	5. Represents Satan's attitude at the time of Man's historical fall.
6. Represents Satan's philosophy in the prehistoric angelic conflict when he was obsessed with self in maximum arrogance.	6. Represents Satan's philosophy as the ruler of the world after the fall of Man. Now he's obsessed with destroying the Plan of God as the #1 enemy of God's Plan.
7. Believer in Cosmic 1 assumes the arrogance of Satan <u>before</u> human history.	7. Believer in Cosmic 2 becomes inculcated with the attitude of Satan <u>during</u> human history.
8. Cosmic 1 believer is slave to self.	8. Cosmic 2 believer is a slave to Satan.
