## **COVENANTS DEFINED**

Definition: (American College Dictionary) "Covenant - an agreement between two or more persons to do or refrain from doing some act"; "a contract"; "a clause of agreement."

Israel's contract that Elijah first build an altar, was God's command according to I Kings 18:31. The ALTAR represents the Covenants to Israel.

- 1. Covenants to Israel are defined as favorable disposition. In a contract, there are two parties:
  - ➤ Party of the First part God, and Party of the Second part man (Client Nation).
  - The Word "CLIENT" means under the patronage (support) of another. The Client Nation is made up of Believers under the PATRONAGE OF GOD. God made a favorable disposition to be part of the second part-Client Nation.
- 2. Covenants to Israel cover two separate Dispensations: The First Dispensation is Israel all past, except for 7 years of the Tribulation.
  - > The Second Dispensation is the Millennium. This contract applies to both periods.
  - ➤ The First Client Nation began with the Exodus Israel became the first Client nation in history; this went all the way to AD 70 (from BC 1440 to AD 70).
  - ➤ We then have the times of the Gentiles Church Age.
  - > There will then be the completion of Israel during the Tribulation followed by the Second Advent.
  - ➤ Israel is the first Client Nation to God, and also will be the *last* Client nation to God. Therefore, these Covenants, (contracts) apply to the dispensation of Israel and the dispensation of the Millennium.
- 3. A Covenant to Israel must not be confused with a *WILL* or *TESTAMENT*. The expression *OLD TESTAMENT* or *NEW TESTAMENT* is a mistranslation of the Hebrew word *Berith*, which means *OLD COVENANT*. A Testament is a will after someone dies. These Covenants deal with Client Nation Israel. God lives eternally, and cannot die, so there is no such thing as a Will or Testament. *Diatheke* is the Greek Word meaning the *New Covenant* or contract.
