

The City Reflects His Glory; Revelation 21:11, 12

VERSE 11 – GLORY OF THE CITY

[Hebrews 2:9](#) *“but we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory an honor; that He by the grace of God should taste death for everyman.”*

- I. Glory is used in the Bible for the Essence of God ([Rom. 3:23](#); [Eph. 1:17](#); [Ps. 21:5](#)).
- II. Glory is used for the spiritual house of the soul ([Eph. 3:21](#), [Col. 1:25-27](#); [1 Peter 1:8](#); [2 Thess. 2:14](#)).
- III. Glory is also related to marriage. The right companion is the glory of the right husband ([I Cor. 1:7, 15](#)).
- IV. The Grace of God is described as Glory ([Eph. 1:16](#)).
- V. God’s provisions are called riches of Glory ([Eph. 3:16](#); [Heb. 2:10](#); [Phil. 4:19](#); [Eph. 1:18](#)).
- VI. Heaven and eternal life are described as Glory ([I Tim. 3:16](#); [I Pet. 5:10](#); [II Pet. 1:3](#)).
- VII. Glory is used to describe the wonders of the universe ([I Cor. 15:40, 41](#)).
- VIII. Glory is used to describe the resurrection body of the believer ([I Cor. 15:43](#); [II Thess. 2:14](#)).
- IX. Glory is associated with the presentation of the church as the bride of Christ at the Second Advent. The bride is the glory of the Groom, who *is* the Glory ([Heb. 2:10](#)).
- X. There are a few verses in the Bible where glamour is mistranslated glory ([I Pet. 1:24](#); [Phil 3:19](#)).
