   Vs. 15 – "gold reed" was about 10 feet long measured" God measures what is His

REVELATION 21:12-27 (Continued)

Revelation 21:19 – Foundations:

Chalcedony – derived from Chalcedon, an ancient name for a city in modern Turkey. The gem is a sky-blue agate stone with translucent, colored stripes.

<u>Revelation 21:20</u> – Foundation (continued) – Sardonyx – a variety of chalcedony with parallel layers of red and white. Sardius – Common stone from the quartz family. Its color ranges from orange-red to brownish-red to a blood-red (<u>Rev. 4:3</u>).

Chrysolite – Transparent gold or yellowish tone.

Beryl – A variety of gems, green emerald to golden yellow beryl.

Topaz – A softer stone, yellow or green color.

Chrysoprasus – An apple-green variety of quartz.

Jacinth – usually red or reddish-brown. The one John saw was blue or shining violet in color.

Amethyst – clear quartz – ranging from faint purple to intense purple.

Revelation 21:21 – "one pearl" Each gate a single, 15 hundred mile high pearl.

Revelation 22, 23 – "no temple" – one in Heaven BUT NOT HERE (Rev. 3:12; 7:15; 11:19; 15:5); THE PRESENCE OF GOD FILLS THE ENTIRE NEW HEAVEN AND NEW EARTH (vs. 23).

<u>Revelation 24</u> – "nations" – literally "the peoples"; these are the redeemed from every walk of life – no divisions, no barriers, no exclusions.

Revelation 25-27 – "gates not shut" – no night – only those who have the name in the BOOK of LIFE.
