VIRGIN BIRTH OF JESUS CHRIST (Reference – Luke 1:35)

- I. Only one man in history.
- II. Jesus was born apart from any act of human copulation.
- III. Since the sinful nature is passed down to the human race through the human father, it was necessary that Jesus not have an earthly father.
- IV. In the Garden, the man sinned in awareness, but the woman sinned in ignorance.
- V. All members of humanity except Jesus are born spiritually dead.
- VI. The only way to enter into the human race without an old sinful nature (OSN) was by a virgin birth.
- VII. Jesus Christ entered physical life without imputed sin (Adam's original sin) and lived a sinless life which qualified Him to be the Savior of mankind.
- VIII. Had there been no virgin birth, there would have been no salvation. He arrived at the cross without having committed one personal sin. No OSN, no imputed sin, no personal sin, qualified Him to be the unique person of the universe.
